Required application documents:	1) NU application form downloadable at https://shorturl.asia/g1iTm or QR Code as shown: 2) A statement of purpose 3) A nomination letter from your university's International Office or Dean, endorsing all applying students for the participation in this exchange program. 3) A copy of passport valid for at least 6 months prior to the program commencement (if any and can be submitted after nomination) 4) A full coverage overseas travel insurance (can be submitted after nomination)
How to apply	Applications must be submitted by the home university. Each university may nominate up to two participants, along with two alternate participants, to Naresuan University. (Division of International Affairs and Language Development).
Deadline for nomination	Thursday, 3 July 2025
Confirmation of acceptance	Wednesday, 9 July 2025 The acceptance letter will be issued to the home university.
Visa	Participants are required to check the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website for details related to their respective countries before entering Thailand.
Airport Transfers	Both pick-ups and drop-offs are available only at Phitsanulok Airport.
Accommodation	13 nights of accommodation will be arranged for all participants at on-campus dormitory (NU Dorm). Each room is arranged on a twin-sharing basis. NU Dorm provides fully furnished accommodation to its occupants, replete with amenities such as AC, electric fans, desks, wardrobes, lamps, bathroom facilities, water heaters, and clotheslines. Any participants who arrive before our program commences after the program schedule, will be required to make their own accommodation arrangements.
